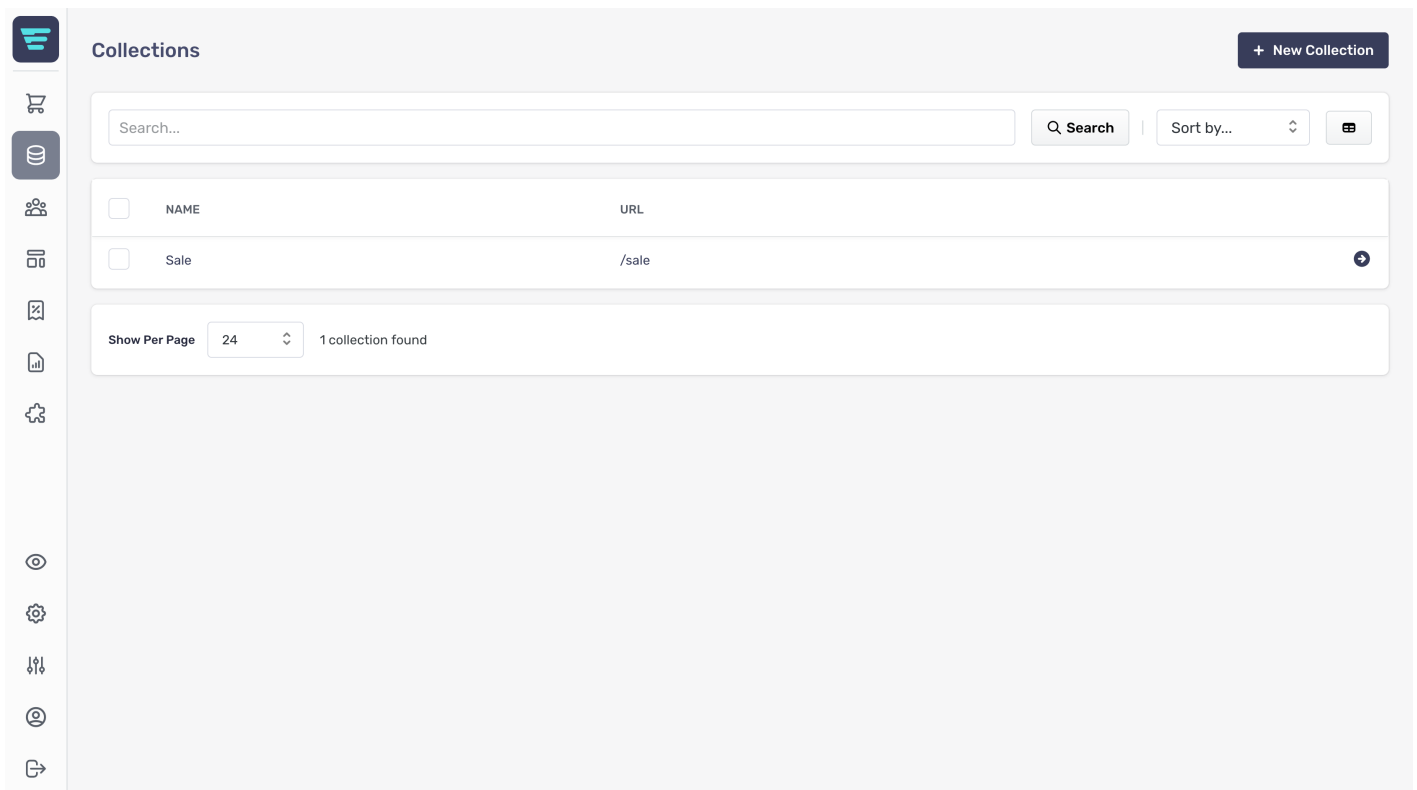


Introduction to collections
