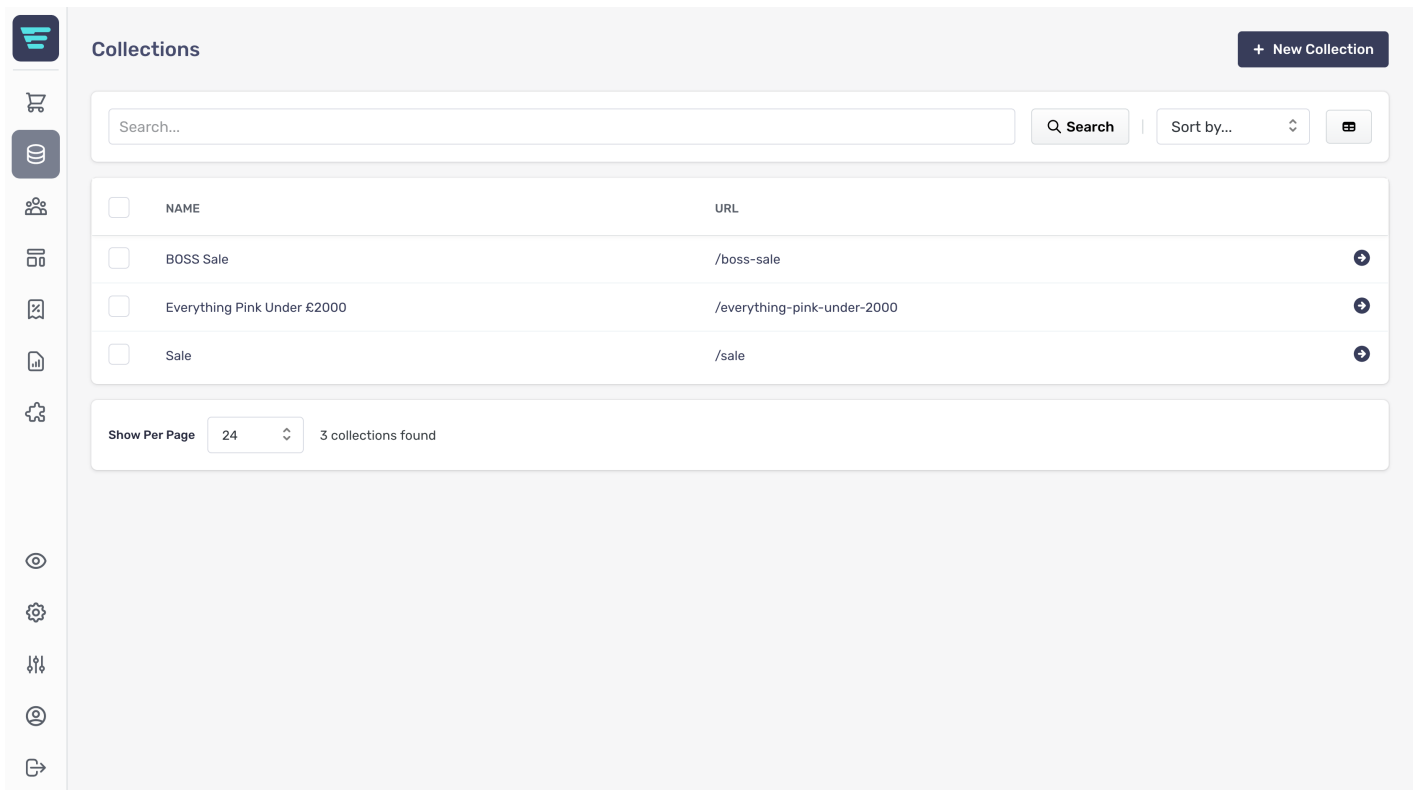


What is the collections list?
